

You are welcome to knit this pattern for loved ones. Do not reproduce and sell the pattern itself.

EASY BABY BLANKET – KNIT-ALONG – SQUARE 7 – BABY CABLES



Stitches Used
Stocking Stitch

All RS rows: Knit all sts

All WS rows: Purl all sts

Baby Cables Stitch

Row 1 (RS): [P2, k2] to last 2 sts, p2

Row 2: K2, [p2, k2] to end

Row 3: [p2, RT[†]] to last 2 sts, p2

Row 4: Repeat Row 2

Dimensions of finished rectangle: 17cm x 24cm

Yarn: Approx. 50 metres Value Ball Gradients (colour scheme "Naturals") in medium brown

Needles: 4mm straight needles

Tension: 22 sts x 26 rows = 10cm² in Baby Cables

Stitch

Notions: Craft scissors, tapestry needle, row

A Note on Colours Used

This is a knit-along pattern for one square of 16 to go into a baby blanket pattern. This project uses

five colours:

Colour 1: Cream

Colour 2: Fawn

Colour 3: Light brown

Colour 4: Medium brown



[†]RT = Right Twist. K2tog, but do not drop stitches from left needle. Insert right needle between the two stitches just worked. Knit first stitch again, then slip both stitches from the left needle together.

Pattern

Cast on 32 sts.

Work 2 rows in Stocking Stitch, starting with a WS row.

Row 3: P4, [p5, m1] to last 3 sts, p3. 38 sts.

Keeping first and last 2 sts in Stocking Stitch, work rows 1-4 of Baby Cables pattern 14 times total.

Next row: K3, k2tog, [k4, k2tog] to last 3 sts, k3. 32sts.

Next Row: P all sts.

Cast off knit-wise.

Weave in ends. Block to finish.
