
EASY BABY BLANKET – KNIT-ALONG – SQUARE 4 – LITTLE RABBITS STITCH



Stitches Used

Stocking Stitch

All RS rows: Knit all sts

All WS rows: Purl all sts

Little Rabbits Stitch

Row 1 (WS): Using dark brown, knit all sts.

Row 2: Using light brown, [k1, slip 1 wyib] to last stitch, k1.

Row 3: Using light brown, k1, [slip 1 wyif, k1] to end.

Rows 4 and 5: Using dark brown, knit all sts.

Row 6: Using light brown, k1, [k1, slip 1 wyib] to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 7: Using light brown, k2, [slip 1 wyif, k1] to last st, k1.

Row 8: Using dark brown, knit all sts.

Dimensions of finished rectangle: 17cm x 24cm

Yarn: Approx. 28 metres Value Ball Gradients (colour scheme "Naturals") in dark brown and approx.. 22 metres in light brown.

Needles: 4mm straight needles

Tension: 18 sts x 40 rows = 10cm² in Little Rabbits Stitch

Notions: Craft scissors, tapestry needle, row counter

A Note on Colours Used

This is a knit-along pattern for one square of 16 to go into a baby blanket pattern. This project uses five colours:

Colour 1: Cream

Colour 2: Fawn

Colour 3: Light brown

Colour 4: Medium brown

Colour 5: Dark brown



Pattern

Cast on 31 sts. Work 5 rows in stocking stitch, starting with a RS row.

While slipping the first two sts of every row and working the last two sts of every row in stocking stitch, work 40 rows in Little Rabbits Stitch (ten pattern repeats total).

You may wish to use stitch markers after the first two stitches and before the last two stitches to show where the Little Rabbit Stitch is to be worked.

Work 5 rows in stocking stitch. Cast off all stitches.

Weave in ends. Steam block to finish.
