
EASY BABY BLANKET – KNIT-ALONG – SQUARE 8 – RAISED STRIPES STITCH



Stitches Used

Stocking Stitch

All RS rows: Knit all sts

All WS rows: Purl all sts

Raised Stripes Stitch

Row 1 (WS): Using fawn, knit all sts

Row 2: Knit all sts

Row 3: Using medium brown, knit all sts

Row 4: P all sts

Dimensions of finished rectangle: 17cm x 24cm

Yarn: Approx. 42 metres Value Ball Gradients (colour scheme "Naturals") in medium brown and approx. 14 metres in fawn.

Needles: 4mm straight needles

Tension: 19 sts x 30 rows = 10cm² in Raised Stripes Stitch

Notions: Craft scissors, tapestry needle, row counter

A Note on Colours Used

This is a knit-along pattern for one square of 16 to go into a baby blanket pattern. This project uses five colours:

Colour 1: Cream

Colour 2: Fawn

Colour 3: Light brown

Colour 4: Medium brown

Colour 5: Dark brown



Pattern

Cast on 32 sts. Work 2 rows in Stocking Stitch, starting with a WS row, using medium brown.

Keeping first and last 2 sts in Stocking Stitch, work raised stripes pattern for 68 rows (17 pattern repeats total).

Work 2 rows in Stocking Stitch in medium brown. Cast off all stitches purl-wise.

Weave in ends. Steam block to finish.
