
EASY BABY BLANKET – KNIT-ALONG – SQUARE 15 – BASKETWEAVE STITCH



Stitches Used

Stocking Stitch

All RS rows: Knit all sts

All WS rows: Purl all sts

Basketweave Stitch

Row 1: K4 [k4, p4] four times, k4

Row 2: P4, [k4, p4] four times, k4

Row 3: As Row 1

Row 4: As Row 2

Dimensions of finished rectangle: 17cm x 24cm

Yarn: Approx. 55 metres Value Ball Gradients (colour scheme "Naturals") in light brown.

Needles: 4mm straight needles

Tension: 19 sts x 26 rows = 10cm² in Stocking Stitch

Notions: Craft scissors, tapestry needle, row counter

A Note on Colours Used

This is a knit-along pattern for one square of 16 to go into a baby blanket pattern. This project uses five colours:

Colour 1: Cream

Colour 2: Fawn

Colour 3: Light brown

Colour 4: Medium brown

Colour 5: Dark brown



Row 5: K4, [p4, k4] four times, k4

Row 6: P4, [p4, k4] four times, p4

Row 7: As Row 5

Row 8: As Row 6

Pattern

Cast on 31 sts. Work 5 rows in Stocking Stitch, beginning with a WS row.

Keep first and last 4 sts in Stocking Stitch throughout. In between these stitches, work rows 1-8 of Basketweave Stitch five times total. Then work rows 1-4 of Basketweave stitch one more time.

Work 5 rows in Stocking Stitch, beginning with a RS row. Cast off purl-wise.

Weave in ends. Steam block to finish.
