
EASY BABY BLANKET – KNIT-ALONG – SQUARE 16 – LADDER STITCH



Stitches Used

Stocking Stitch

All RS rows: Knit all sts

All WS rows: Purl all sts

Ladder Stitch

Row 1 (WS): Using medium brown, k2 [sl 1 wyib, k5] to last 3 sts, sl 1 wyib, k2.

Row 2: P2, [sl 1 wyif, p5] to last 3 sts, sl 1 wyif, p2.

Row 3: Using fawn, [k5, sl 1 wyib] to end.

Row 4: K2, p1, k2, [sl 1 wyif, k2, p1, k2] to end.

Dimensions of finished rectangle: 17cm x 24cm

Yarn: Approx. 30 metres Value Ball Gradients (colour scheme "Naturals") in fawn and approx. 26 metres in medium brown.

Needles: 4mm straight needles

Tension: 21 sts x 36 rows = 10cm² in Ladder Stitch

Notions: Craft scissors, tapestry needle, row counter

A Note on Colours Used

This is a knit-along pattern for one square of 16 to go into a baby blanket pattern. This project uses five colours:

Colour 1: Cream

Colour 2: Fawn

Colour 3: Light brown

Colour 4: Medium brown

Colour 5: Dark brown



Pattern

Cast on 35 sts. Using fawn, work 5 rows in Stocking Stitch, beginning with a WS row.

Keeping first and last 3 sts in Stocking Stitch, work in Ladder Stitch pattern for 64 rows (16 pattern repeats total).

Using fawn, work 5 rows in Stocking Stitch, beginning with a RS row. Cast off all stitches purl-wise.

Weave in ends. Steam block to finish.
